REGULATION

Article 1: Organization

IES is a tournament organized by AS Lyon1-EPUL's and ISEG's Sport Office.

Article 2: Regulations

In addition to articles and specifications of this regulation, the national FFSU regulation will be applied at the sporting and technical level. If there is a disagreement between our rules and FFSU's one, the later will be applied.

Article 3: Competitors

The IES is opened to students who have a student Identification and a medical certification for the sport the student will play (Volleyball or Football).

Article 4: Participation fees

Each team who wants to take part in this competition should pay, at least 10 days before the tournament begins the 15 Euros per person. The fees take into account the 2 nights at the hotel as well as the meals. Travel costs are borne by the teams.

Article 5: IES specifications

Football

The football tournament is a 7 players football tournament: 1 goal keeper and 6 field players.

Game progression:

- 1st half: 30 minutes
- Half time break: 10 minutes
- 2nd half: 10 minutes

There will be no additional time

Any player receiving a red card will not play for the rest of the game and will be suspended for the next game.

Volleyball

The women's volleyball tournament will be played in 2 sets win.

Article 6:

Whether it is football or volleyball, the tournament will take place as follow:

- 16 teams for each tournament are registered.
- Teams must play with the colours they indicated in the accession form.
- Each player must have a numbered jersey.
- Each team must come with its own balls for their trainings.

Saturday April 3rd: First round tournament

The tournament will take place as follow:

4 groups constituted with 4 teams.

In each group, all teams meet each other. So for the first day, 3 games per team will be played.

The classification will be done as follow:

- Win: 5 points
- Draw: 3 points
- Defeat: 1 point

Then, a classification will be done. Only the teams who finished the first round as first and second will be qualified for the finals.

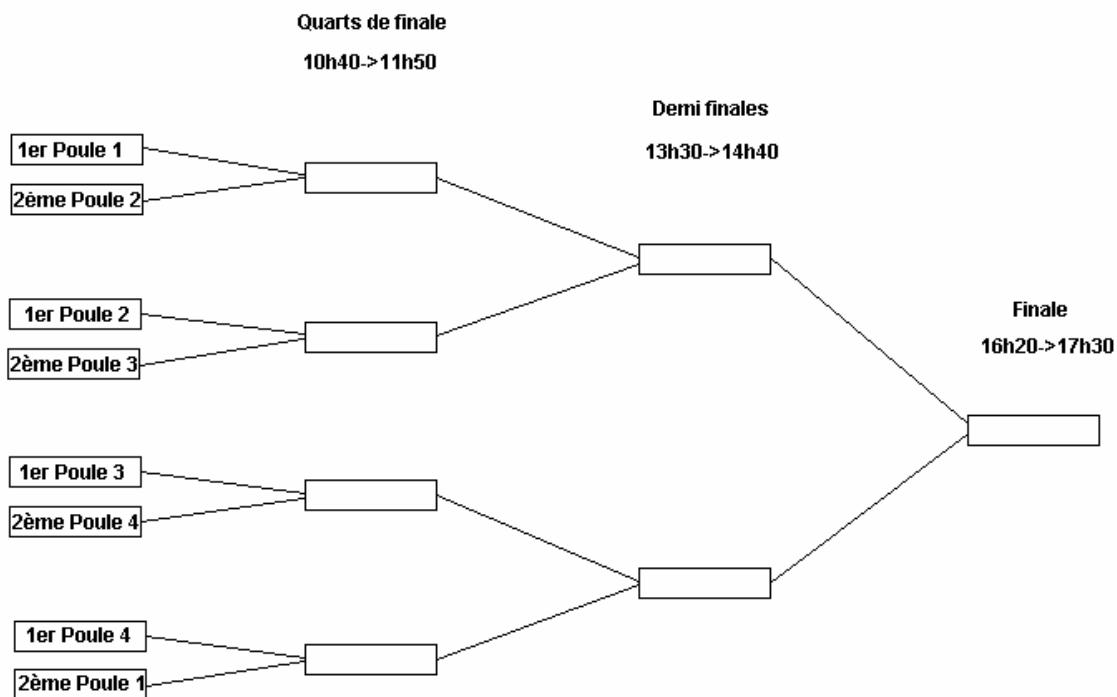
The 3rd and 4th teams will play the classification games.

In case of tie, the classification will be done as follow:

1. Particular goal difference
2. Goal difference
3. Goal scored
4. Yellow and red cards
5. Lottery

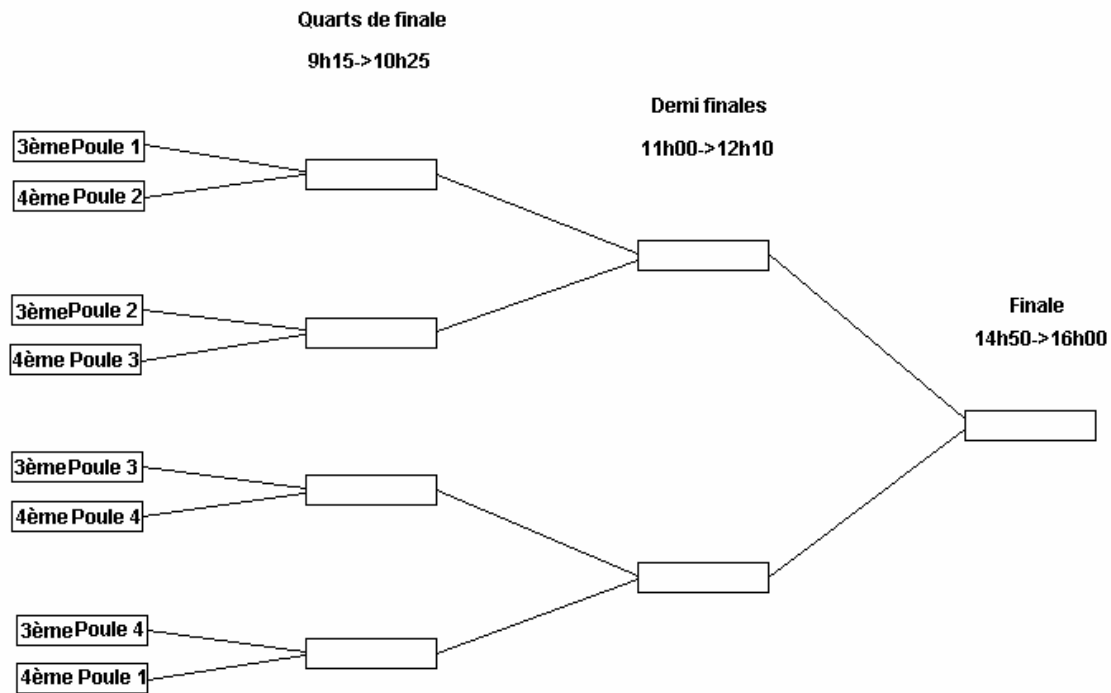
Sunday, April 4th

Classification games for the 3rd and 4th of the groups: Second Table



Then a classification will be done:

1st: Final game winner.

2nd: Final game loser.

3rd: 3rd place game winner.

4th: 3rd place game loser.

5th (tie): Teams who lost the quarter final games

9th: Final game winner of the second table

10th: Final game loser of the second table

11th (tie): semi finals losers of the second table

13th (tie): quarter finals losers of the second table

Article 7:

Each captain or team manager must attend the captains meeting scheduled Saturday, April 3rd at 8 AM. Games schedules, recommendations and team files with instructions will be distributed.

The captain or manager must show the players medical certificate to be conformed to the inscription form.

Each player who is not in the form would not be able to take part in the tournament.

Modification can be made until Thursday April the 1st.

Article 8:

Match schedules will be sent by email, at the email address given in the form, to each team on Wednesday March 31st.

Article 9: Reclamation

Each team has the right to claim reclamation. It must be written and will be received exclusively by the board of referee. The board of referees will decide without delay.

Article 10:

Any other point this regulation does not take in account will be examined by the board of referees. Its decision will be undisputable.

Article 11:

Being involved implies that any player will read the rules and accept the terms.
